- Flipped lecture format worked really well for me and the time taken to ask questions before quizzes was really beneficial for anything I didn't get before class








- Although I understand that the flip classroom approach is used to prepare us for the future, it was hard to fully grasp the concepts sometimes.







- 6 Every class had group work as well as our final presentations.





- I enjoy the group set up of the class and how everyone sits at a table in a group of four. it's refreshing to know that you're all in this together.







- 9 Dr. Larimore is extremely good at what she does and I look forward to classes and opportunities with her in the future.






