



Q2 - If your class year is other, please specify.

Q4 - If the reason you took the course is other, please explain.




Q8 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

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
- 1 We were pushed to study hard and do our best.


Response Rate: 36.84% (7 of 19)

 classwork and with the quizzes and I would study for them.


- 4 I tried to be as prepared as I could, and always went except for when I was suffering from a migraine.





- 9 Dr. Larimore was very helpful with any questions or concerns I had, and always answered in a timely manner.




Q20 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

- B. Dr. Larimore took the time to explain concepts and find specific pages in the book where they had been discussed to help with further understanding.




Q22 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

- Always a fun classroom to be in and there would always be great conversations




Q24 - Please explain or comment on the question above.
