It would be helpful if some of the topics in lecture videos had more descriptions. Some of the topics, which are hard to understand easily, 7 were needed more in-person discussions.

I believe the test for this course was the main ineffective piece. I appreciate the test corrections to help our understanding. I recommend 8 going over during a class period over the most top five missed question on the test to make sure we reeved further explanation.
