This is probably the worst course I've ever taken in college and even worse than high school courses. Biology- especially the foundations of biology really needs to be taught and explained well to fully understand it, especially with the sheer volume of information being thrown at students in a quick amount of time. This course was far too demanding outside of class as a 100-level course. Yes, time should be dedicated to this course outside of class, but I spent hours outside of class just working through the chapters, taking notes, finishing mastering assignments, and barely being able to review. I felt like I barely learned most of the semester and gained nothing from this course. The flipped classroom style does not work for this course without the instructor actually teaching. Reading directly off the slides and staring at the screen at the start of a class isn't teaching and students gain nothing from this. I talked with many other students in this class as well, and we all expressed our grievances and disappointment in the lack of teaching in this class. As someone who has already taken college-level biology in high school in a lecture-based format and other classes in a lecture-based format, it is very disappointing and discouraging that the class and instructor almost do not have any actual class instruction at all. The grades in this class do not seem like a true reflection of the students or our capabilities at all. We pay for college to be taught, not to have to teach ourself from a laptop.
