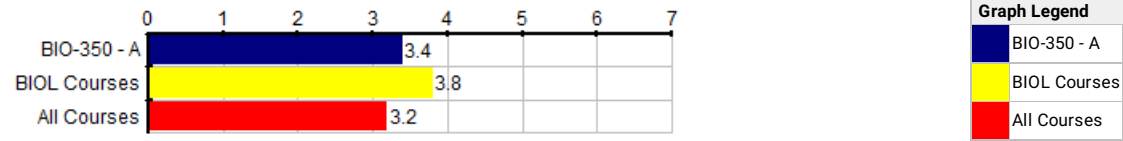

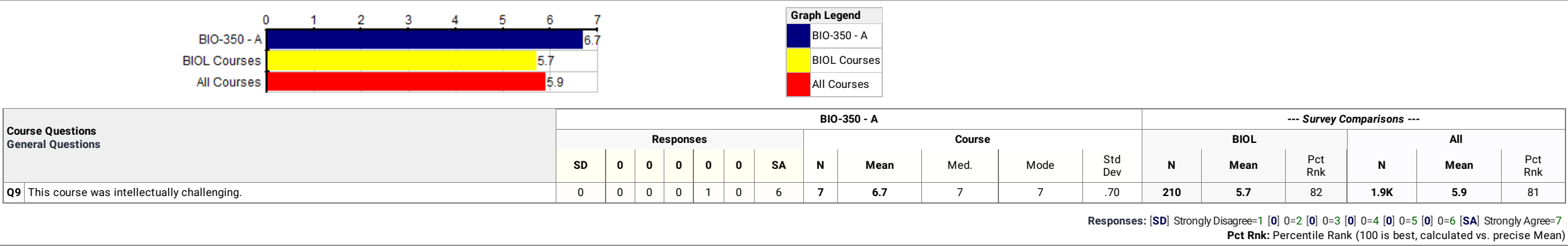
Q6 - Please explain or comment on the question above .

5	I did not know any neuro topics, but now I am surprised how much I can understand an article now.



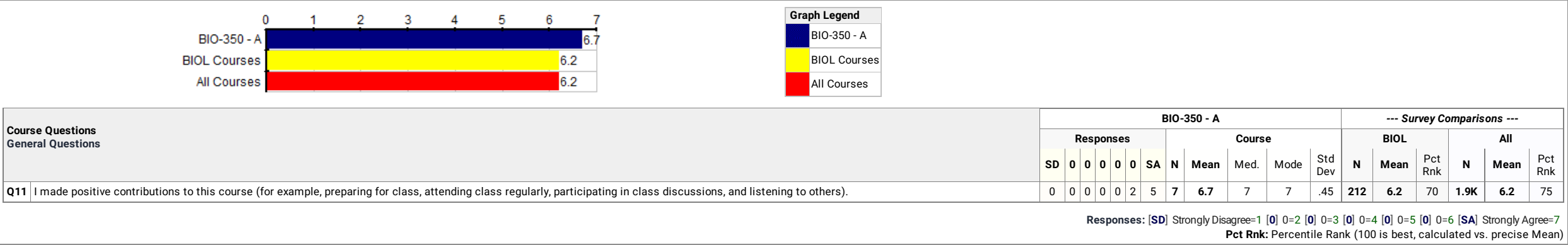

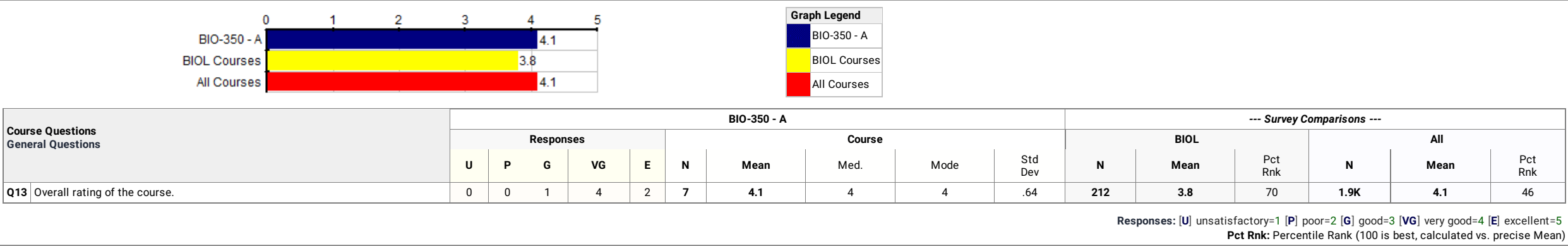
Q8 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

1	There was an excess amount of quizzes in this course that added more stress than helping me learn the material, especially on the article quizzes, I don't believe it is necessary since we already do presentations on those. In addition, the concept maps have not been helpful for me personally considering how time-consuming they are to make in addition to reading and taking notes on the chapter. i find ARQ's are more useful when studying for exams because it is more specific in letting us know which parts of the chapter would show up on the exam. Concept maps might be helpful to some students though so I suggest we get a choice of which weekly assignment we turn in from either ARQ's or concept maps.
2	The textbook and the lectures do not match. It is as if the lectures were derived from a completely different textbook. It felt like reading the textbook was doing more harm then good because it felt like a waste of time that we did not have that much of. The lecture slides sometimes had mistakes and did not always do a great job in explaining things. Sometimes there would just be statements without proper introduction that were quite confusing to understand if not explained properly.
3	The article presentations were a good learning experience when I was the one presenting, but a bit of a waste of time when just listening to presentation.
4	I thought that the lectures moved really quickly through the material and made it difficult to keep up with notes wise, however, there was a lot of material to cover so I understand why we had to move quickly.



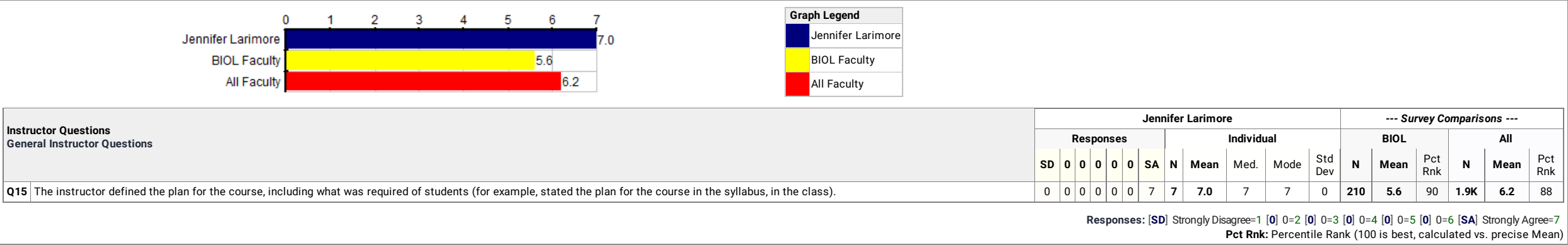
Q10 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

3	Not as challenging as I expected. Yes, I had to schedule more study time than other classes, but once I got the hang of it, it was not as challenging as it could be.



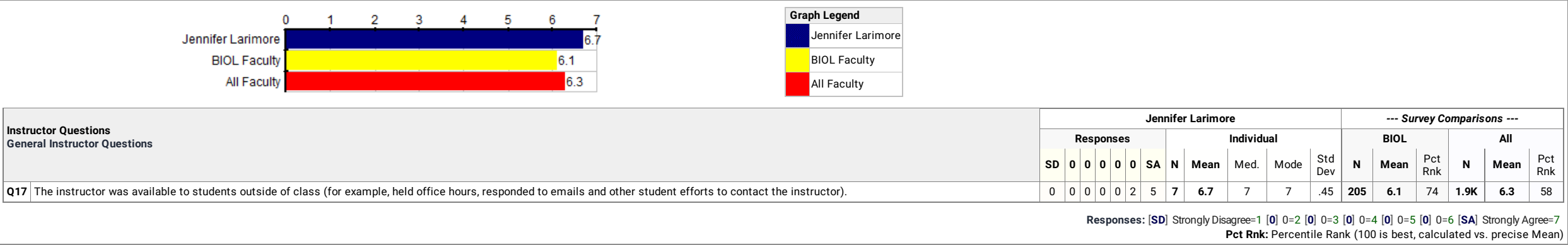
Q12 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

3	I appreciate Dr. Larimore allowing us to interrupt her lecture for questions.



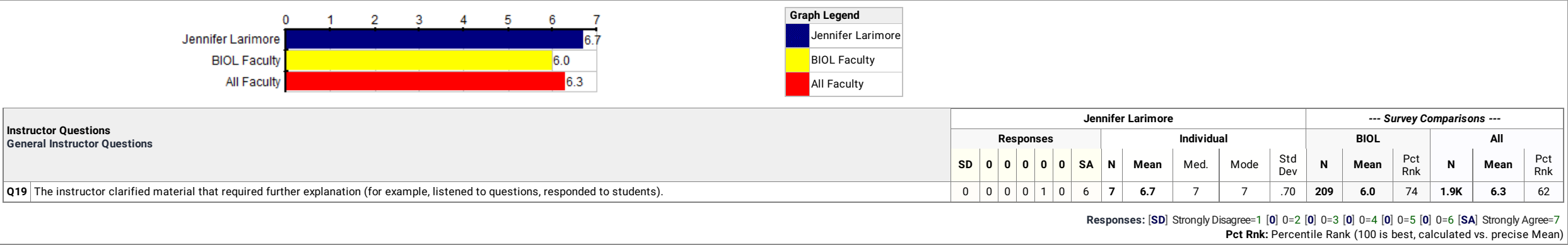
Q14 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

2	I definitely think this class helped with my future aspirations in preparing us with career success. It also prepared me for the rigor that is ahead of me in future courses.



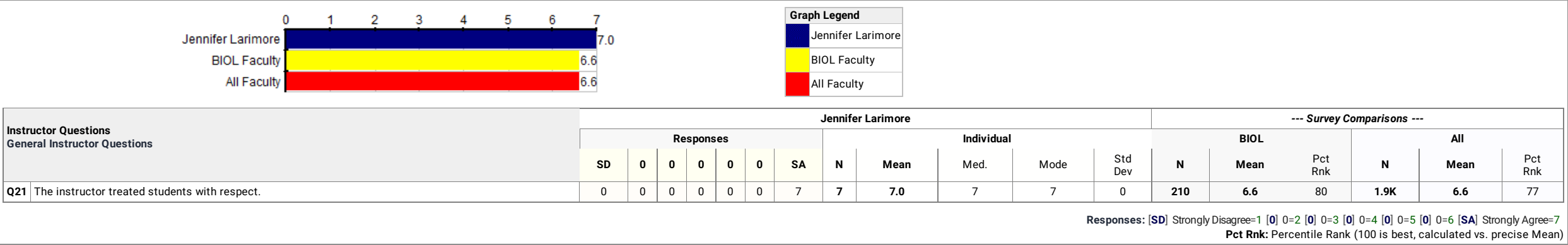

3	The syllabus and Canvas pages were always very organized



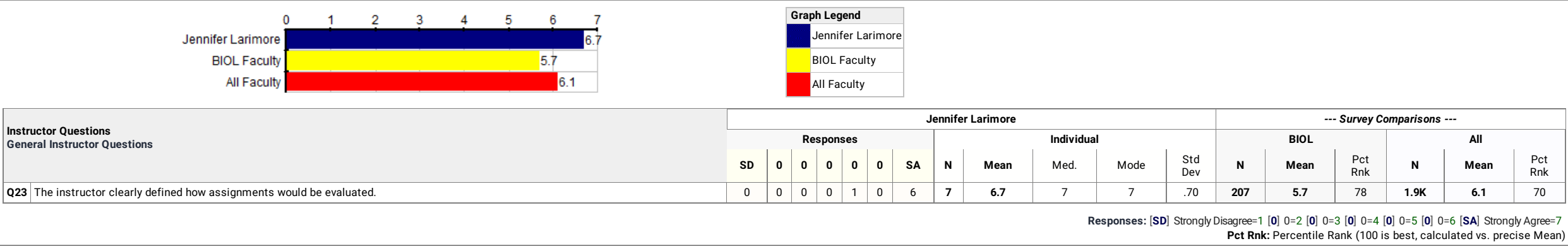
Q18 - Please explain or comment on the question above.

2	She always listened to questions and always answered them appropriately without falling off topic and encouraged students to ask her more questions and voice their concerns.

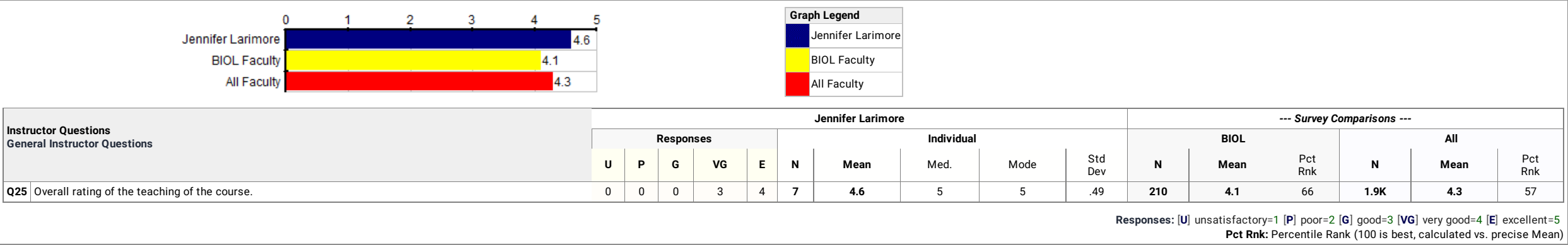


Q22 - Please explain or comment on the question above.
